FEED THE HUNGRY - ANNAYOJANA, VASHI

Addressing the hunger faced by relatives accompanying patients at the Vashi Municipal hospital, this initiative offers free lunches and bottled water to about 150 - 200 individuals every Saturday. We started this project in the year 2017. We are providing free packets of food in the noon time with the financial support of our faithful and volunteer activity of Vashi parish MGOCSM, OCYM and other church members in preparing the food



LEAD BY THY LIGHT - TEJASWINI SCHOOL, VASHI



Tejaswini School provides quality education by integrating modern technology, such as the TeachNext Smart Class system, to create an engaging learning environment at no cost to 450 - 500 students annually, from the slums of Turbhe. The school's impact is reflected in the success of its alumni, who have excelled in various fields, demonstrating its commitment to student empowerment and future growth.

EMBRACE - GREGORIAN SPECIAL SCHOOL, ROHA

The Gregorian Special School in Roha, founded by H.G. Geevarghese Mar Coorilos, provides a nurturing environment for children with developmental challenges, empowering them to reach their full potential. Serving around 17 children, it offers personalized education, therapy, and life skills training through various initiatives. With a significant financial commitment, the school stands as a beacon of hope for families navigating the challenges of special needs education in and around Roha.



CARE 2 SHARE - GREGORIAN CARE CENTRE, ROHA

The Gregorian Care Centre in Roha, established in 2006, provides a safe and nurturing home for senior citizens, especially those without support. It offers comfortable lodging, nutritious meals, medical care, and emotional well-being programs, ensuring residents live with dignity and peace. The Centre fosters a fulfilling and respectful environment for older people through holistic care and a strong sense of community



CANSHARE - DR MAR THEOPHILUS ASHRAYA BHAVAN, NERUL



Dr Mar Theophilus Ashraya Bhavan in Nerul provides free food, accommodation, and transport for cancer patients and their families, easing the financial strain of treatment in Mumbai. Established in 2019, it supports around 600+ patients annually, ensuring they focus on recovery without worrying about necessities. This initiative is a beacon of hope, offering care and comfort to those in need.

SHARE 2 GROW - MAR ALVARES WELFARE CENTRE FOR CHILDREN

The Mar Alvares Welfare Centre for Children in Kalamboli, inaugurated in 2023, provides education, nutrition, and healthcare for street children, orphans, and underprivileged youth. It offers a safe space for holistic development, aiming to break the cycle of poverty and exploitation. The centre fosters long-term stability and brighter futures by supporting both children and their families.



MAR ALVARES SNEHA SADAN - Medical Misson, Sawantawadi

Launched in 2023, the Mar Alvares Sneha Sadan Clinic & Village Mobile Medical Van Project provides essential healthcare to six underserved villages near Sawantwadi. A mobile van, staffed by a doctor and nurse, offers free medical consultations, treatments, and medicines, improving access to healthcare. The initiative fosters health awareness, early intervention, and community trust, significantly enhancing residents' well-being.



NUTRITION FOR TB-AFFLICTED CHILDREN - TURBHE



Since 2009, the Diocese of Bombay has run a nutrition program in Turbhe's slums to combat child malnutrition by providing milk and boiled eggs. Initially focused on children with tuberculosis, it later expanded to malnourished children under seven, with support from NNMC and Terana Hospital. After a temporary halt during COVID-19, it resumed in 2023, aiding 30-35 children daily. A unique project, "Five Loaves and an Egg," provides additional nutrition for TB-affected children to improve their immunity and overall health.

EMPOWERING WOMEN - ST. MARY'S TRAINING CENTRE, TURBHE

St. Mary's Training Centre in Turbhe empowers women by providing free skill development courses in tailoring, embroidery, and mehendi art. The program helps women gain confidence, earn a livelihood, and achieve financial independence while fostering community support. By equipping them with practical skills, the initiative enhances economic self-reliance and improves their quality of life.



BE THY LIGHT - EDUCATION AID & SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

St. Mary's School, Vashi, supports underprivileged students by providing free ships and scholarships, ensuring financial constraints do not hinder education. With an annual fee concession of ₹ 35,00,000, the initiative promotes equal opportunities and empowers students to build brighter futures. Donations and sponsorships help sustain this effort, breaking the cycle of poverty through education.



JOIN HANDS - MARRIAGE AID PROGRAM

Join Hands Marriage Aid Program supports 50 couples from economically disadvantaged backgrounds by providing financial assistance to the new family. This initiative aims to uphold the sanctity of marriage, ensuring couples can celebrate their union with dignity, free from financial burdens.



SHELTER UNDER THY WINGS - HOUSING PROJECT



The Shelter Under Thy Wings Housing Project provides safe, secure homes for underprivileged families, offering stability and dignity to those facing housing insecurity. By addressing basic housing needs, the project empowers families to improve their lives and break the cycle of poverty, fostering hope and community. This year we plan to build 10 homes for the less privileged.

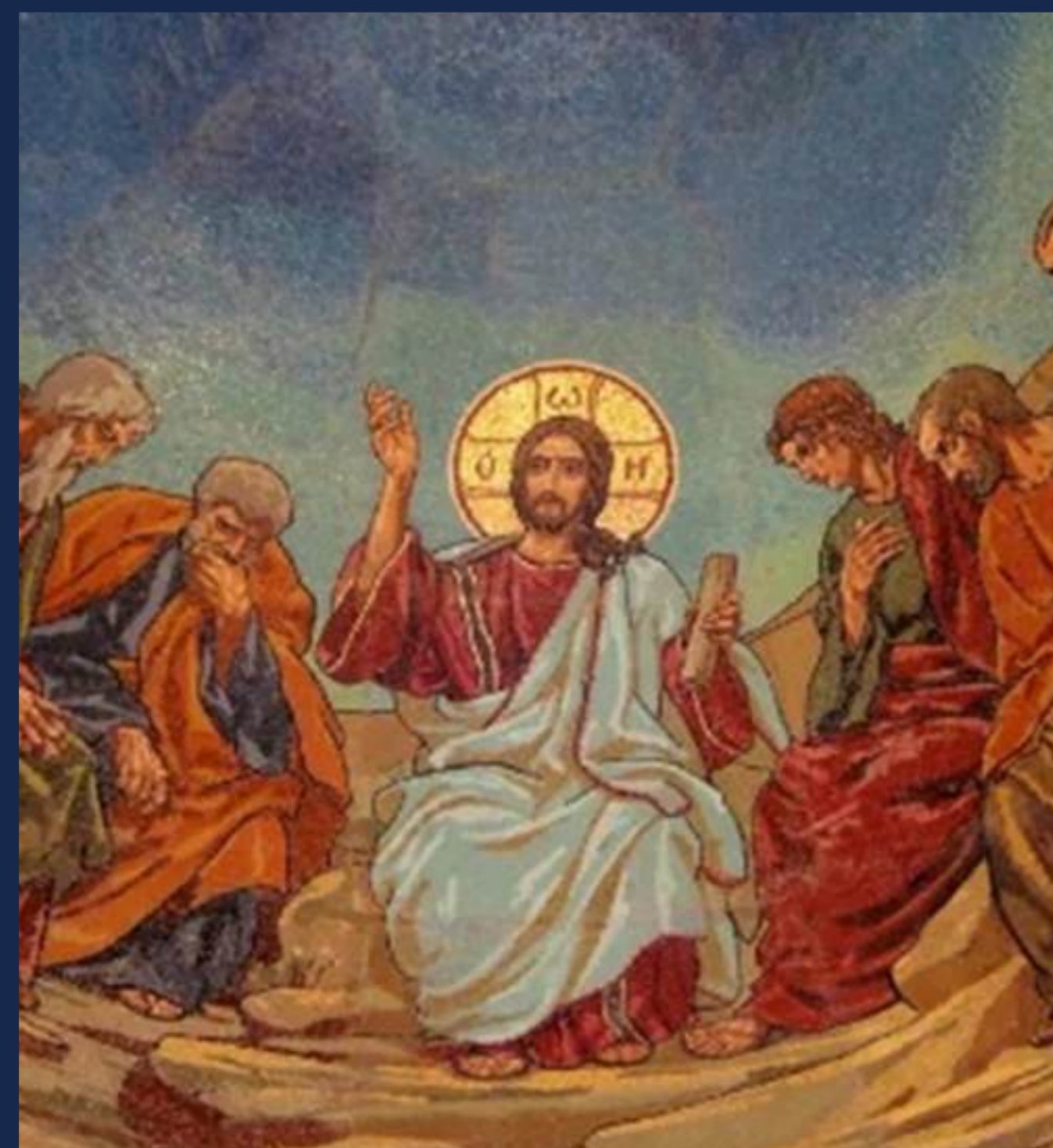
HEALING HANDS - MEDICAL AID PROGRAM
